Steps

- 1. Use your UniSA Study Plan to see what courses may be a good fit to use on your semester exchange
- 2. Research courses at your host institution and gather course information (e.g., detailed course outline)
- 3. List preferred courses on your course planner next to your UniSA course equivalents

When considering your exchange courses, note the following:

- Do you have any electives remaining?
- Are there courses you must complete at UniSA or in Australia?
- Can you re-order your remaining UniSA subjects to make subject matching easier?

Remember, you don't have to use electives for your exchange program; you can use core subjects, majors, or minors. However, using electives can provide the greatest flexibility when making your subject choices.
