Events and activities

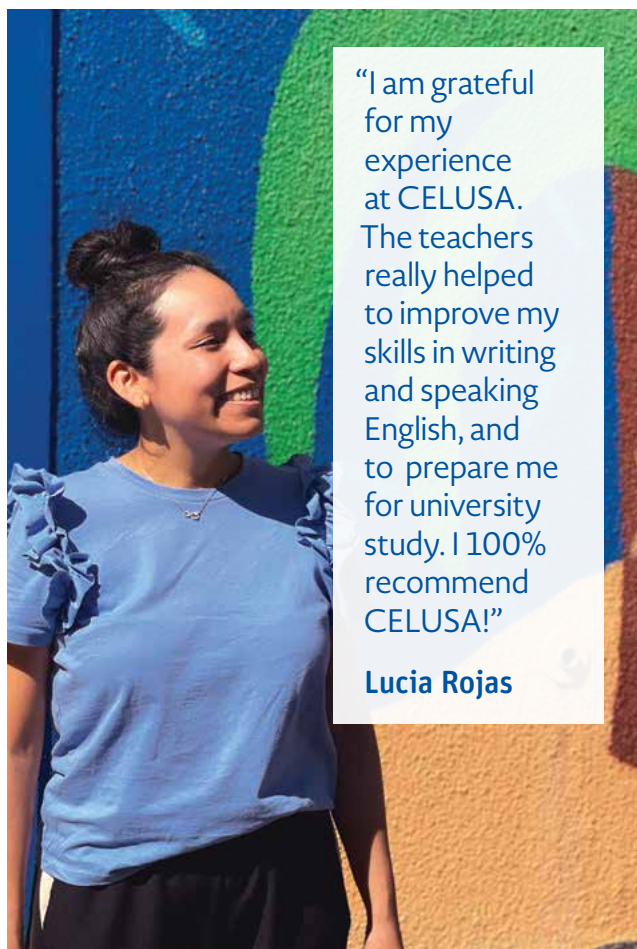
Numerous social events are organised by CELUSA and UniSA throughout the year including sports, sightseeing and BBQ's.
